2. Open Floor: Stacey Austin-Root who presented information regarding the Child Advocacy Center. They have a new program for families; Oswego County Trauma Response Team.

Review of the need to make purchases, suggestions to P. Egan fro budget meeting on 9/6/07
Will also check with CNY EMS for equipment that will be needed for Protocols.
Approval for P. Egan to attend Vital Sign Conference in October in Syracuse.
Review of equipment ordered from the Homeland Security Grant, spent between \$28,000 – 30,000. Some equipment includes lighting for scenes, generators, and heaters. Other items include tools for equipment and retention of EMT's.
Recognized J. Jones for his Regional Council Award for Leadership, NOCA was nominated for participating in the "Storm Protocol".
Review of the Red Cross "Hero Award", would like to see some nominations from Oswego County.
7. Committee Reports:
Education/Training: Original/Refresher in June was successful and did not loose money. P. Egan performed an audit with the refresher at SOVAC, she reviewed with the students the time frame, etc. The students were very agreeable to the class set up and another class may be offered again during the winter. This class was modeled along the same lines as the quick refresher at Montour Falls.
September Basic Original/Refresher to start in Granby with M. McDonald as the instructor. Registration by 8/30/07.
A request has been placed for a CFR course in Central Square with N. Wallis to instruct.
A request has been submitted to J. Jones for a CORE content course for 24 hours. For this CORE class, students will be charged for 1/3 of the state reimbursement, this class will possible be held on Saturdays. This has been reviewed with Oswego County Fire Chiefs and there is a budget line for this now.
P. Egan is trying to recruit M. Murray to teach for the county and she is looking to ~~have an Original Basic class in Cleveland~~. She is hoping to recruit more CIC's.
